Kitchen Garden with Red Hill EEC

UNIT OVERVIEW

Red Hill Environmental Education Centre (EEC) offer an envidence-based **Kitchen Garden** program where students are engaged in one-hour gardening and cooking lessons each week for up to four classes per day. The program is designed for students to achieve educational, wellbeing and sustainability outcomes through curriculum-embedded, cross-KLA learning sequences. The Red Hill EEC Kitchen Garden program teaches a range of life skills and supports critical thinking, communication, problem solving and teamwork skills.

The Red Hill EEC Kitchen Garden program supports schools to measurably increase student engagement and achievement including:

sustainability cross curriculum priority Kitchen Gardens – Program Outline



Students engage with one-hour outdoor gardening and cooking lessons each week led by Red Hill EEC staff. Depending on school scheduling, up to four classes per day can be accomodated.

This program has been proven throughout more than 40 schools across the state.

FACE TO FACE IN-SCHOOL PROGRAM

The Kitchen Garden program includes:

- Red Hill EEC Kitchen Garden teacher 1 day/wk
- up to 4 classes per day
- target Stages 2 / 3, may be adapted to other Stages
- a combination of theory lessons, hands-on gardening activities and cooking

LONG TERM LEARNING COMMITMENT

The Red Hill EEC Kitchen Garden program runs for 2 years to support your school with:

- kitchen garden set up and establishment
- kitchen garden maintenance
- curriculum based learning
- cooking with produce on-site

COSTING OPTIONS

Red Hill EEC have a variety of costing options to select from, depending on the level of support and resources your school requires. All costing options include a Red Hill EEC teacher for 1 day per week for a period of 2 years, with additional staffing provided as required by the program. Other program set up costs may include:

- kitchen garden start-up equipment
- gardening equipment
- cooking/kitchen equipment
